{On 10-29-2014 I was working uniformed patrol as 3D1 in a marked patrol vehicle. At approximately 0124 hours I was dispatched to an assault call at 7 Taylor Ave N s Pizza). The victim of this crime is a pizza delivery driver for s Pizza and was identified as

When I spoke to Victim/ I met her at s Pizza and she stated to me that at approximately 0045 hours she was dispatched to a pizza delivery at 2 Waverly Pl N. V/ stated this was a large order and was valued at over \$100. V/ stated that she got to the listed address and as she was walking up the stairs to the residence, she dropped something and then quickly picked it up. V/ stated that she was already up the stairs when the suspect opened the door and invited her in to drop off the pizza. V/ stated that as she was walking into the house, the suspect began to

put his arm around her and she thought this was weird, but the suspect might have just been being nice since she dropped the pizza. The suspect, after putting his arm around V/ [REDACTED] attempted to kiss her on the lips. V/ [REDACTED] sternly told the suspect that his actions were not okay and she was just there to drop off the pizza.

V/ [REDACTED] had a large arm full of pizza and other food items, so she was unable to hand the delivery off to the suspect so she walked inside to set it in the kitchen. As V/ [REDACTED] was walking into the kitchen, the suspect grabbed her buttocks as she walked by him. V/ [REDACTED] stated again that the suspect's actions were not appreciated and she continued to set the pizza on the counter in the kitchen. After setting the food down, V/ [REDACTED] was able to see out of the corner of her eye that the suspect had his pants around his knees and he was fondling his penis. V/ [REDACTED] stated that she then grabbed her clip board and told the suspect that she needs a signature and if he didn't want to sign, she was going to leave anyways. V/ [REDACTED] stated that she was alarmed by this action and she was visibly shaking as she was leaving the residence.

V/ [REDACTED] also stated that as she was leaving, the suspect made several comments about V/ [REDACTED] "having a quickie for a better tip." V/ [REDACTED] left the residence and went back to [REDACTED]'s Pizza and talked to her boss and then decided to call 911.

Officer Daranciang, V/ [REDACTED] and I responded back to 20 [REDACTED] Waverly Pl N in an attempt to contact the suspect. V/ [REDACTED] knocked on the door several times with no response. V/ [REDACTED] then began announcing that she was the pizza girl and was requesting that the suspect come outside. There was still no answer. I then called the phone number that the suspect gave V/ [REDACTED] for the delivery and I called that phone number, I heard the phone ringing inside and then a male answered. I handed the phone to V/ [REDACTED] who talked to the male and again told him that this was the pizza girl and she had changed her mind. V/ [REDACTED] stated to the suspect that she was outside and she wanted to be let in. The suspect then asked over the phone, Are you serious? This isn't some police crap is it? The suspect then came to the door and once he opened it, I identified myself as Officer Pendt with the Seattle Police Department. I then asked the suspect if I could step inside and he stated we had permission to go inside.

I placed the suspect in hand cuffs and then identified him as Arrested [REDACTED] via his WSDL. I advised A/ [REDACTED] that he was under arrest for indecent liberties. V/ [REDACTED] positively identified A/ [REDACTED] as the suspect that she originally delivered the pizza's to.

A [REDACTED] requested that we let him grab some shoes and money from his house, so we let him grab shoes, cash and a credit card from one of his back bedrooms.

I then escorted A [REDACTED] to Officer Daranciang's patrol vehicle, searched him incident to arrest, and read him his Miranda warnings approximately three times. A [REDACTED] then requested to read his Miranda warnings from my card, so I let him and he then stated that he understood his rights.

I asked A [REDACTED] for his side of the story, and he stated that the pizza lady delivered the pizza and left and denied any kind of involvement. I then explained to A [REDACTED] what he was being accused of and he stated that he did try to kiss V [REDACTED] but only in a "thank you for coming" kind of way on the cheek. A [REDACTED] then stated that he never grabbed V [REDACTED] buttocks. A [REDACTED] stated that he has been practicing his baseball pitching and he was in the mood for baseball so as V [REDACTED] walked by, he slapped her buttocks just like the baseball players do. A [REDACTED] also stated that the other allegations were false and he would not do anything like that.

I got an audio/video statement from V [REDACTED] on my In Car Video.

I arrested A [REDACTED] for Investigation of Indecent Liberties.

Sgt. Hockett #6358 screened this arrest at the West Precinct.
